

The Procession will assemble in Moorhall Road, South Harefield, by the Half-Way House.

The procession will leave Moorhall Road at 12.30 p.m. turn left into Harvil Road and go up Church Hill, through the village and will enter the Hospital grounds by the gate next to the King's Arms Garage at approximately 1.30 p.m.
