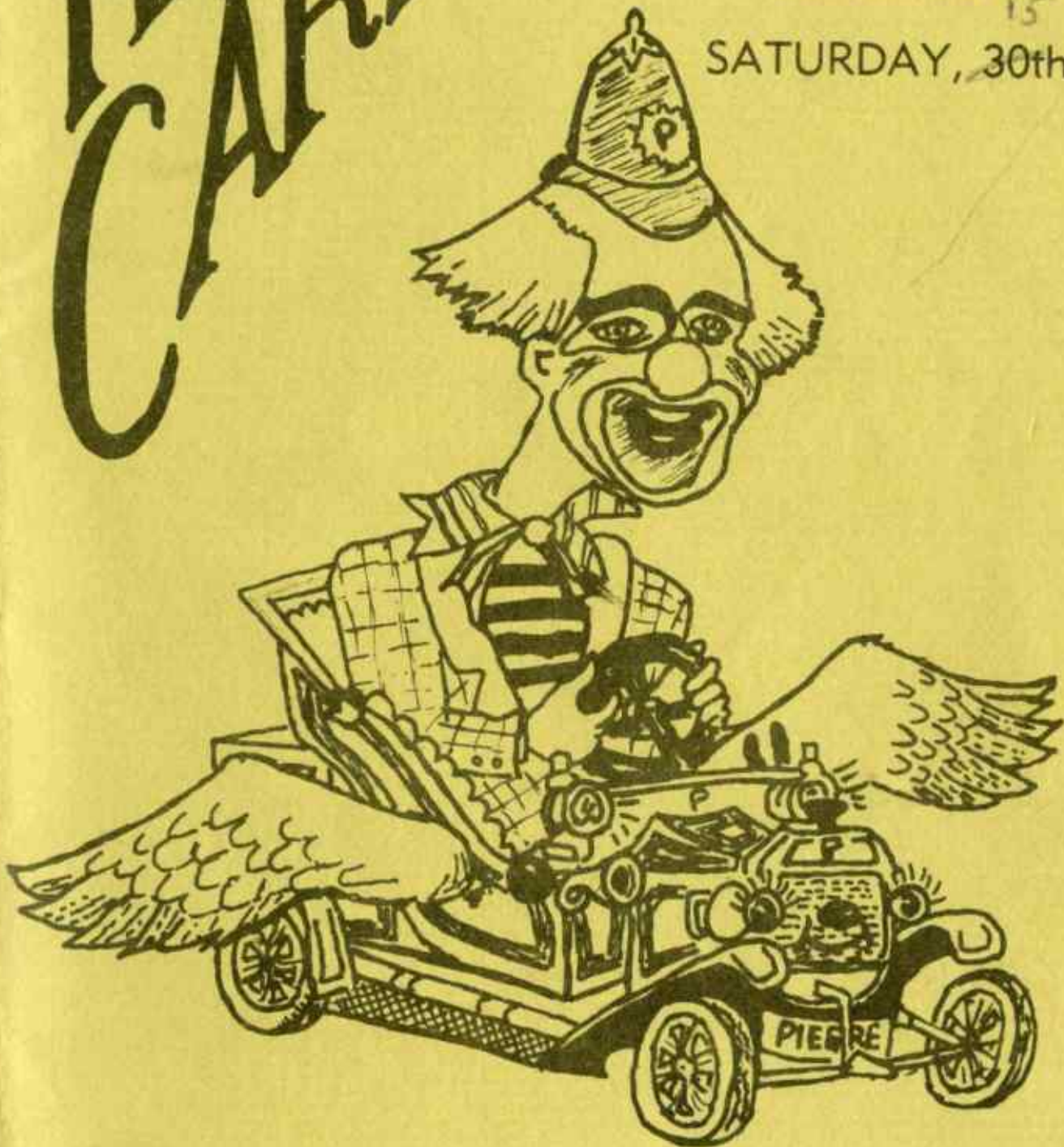

City of Bristol Drum Corps

Leading the procession will be the City of Bristol Drum Corps. The Corps was formed in January 1978, with about 30 boys between the ages of nine and twenty-one.

The following year girls were introduced in the form of a Colour Guard, using flags and more recently imitation rifles to enhance visually the parade and display music.

The Corps now boasts of a membership exceeding eighty strong, and now has girls in the band as well as the Colour Guard.

In January 1980, the Corps were presented with its Colours bearing the City of Bristol Coat of Arms, by the Lord Mayor of Bristol.

Since its formation, the Corps has played at Carnivals and Competitions throughout the country and has appeared several times at football and rugby matches as pre-match entertainment. Cabaret has also proved a popular event with displays at several of Bristol's leading hotels.

VINTAGE VEHICLE DISPLAY

To all our visitors attending the Carnival and Vintage Vehicle Display this year we extend a very hearty welcome. Trusting for good weather, you will have the opportunity of seeing vehicles not only on display, but also being manouvered through set routines in the main areana during the afternoon.

These vehicles range from the 1920's to the middle 60's and give one some idea of the progress that has been made in mechanical and styling design.

The Doina Dance Group

"Doina" is a particular type of Romanian folk music normally played on shepherds' flutes or pan-pipes.

The Doina Dance Group performs dances from all the Eastern European countries, ie: The Soviet Union, Poland, Czechoslovakia, Hungary, Romania, Bulgaria and Yugoslavia. Some of their beautiful costumes are supplied by the Romanian Embassy. They also have Hungarian and Russian costumes.

The group is sponsored by the British/Romanian and British/Hungarian Friendship Societies, the Society for International Folk Dancing and is an officially sponsored cultured group of the London Cooperative Society.

They have appeared on BBC TV and were the subject of a programme on Radio London.

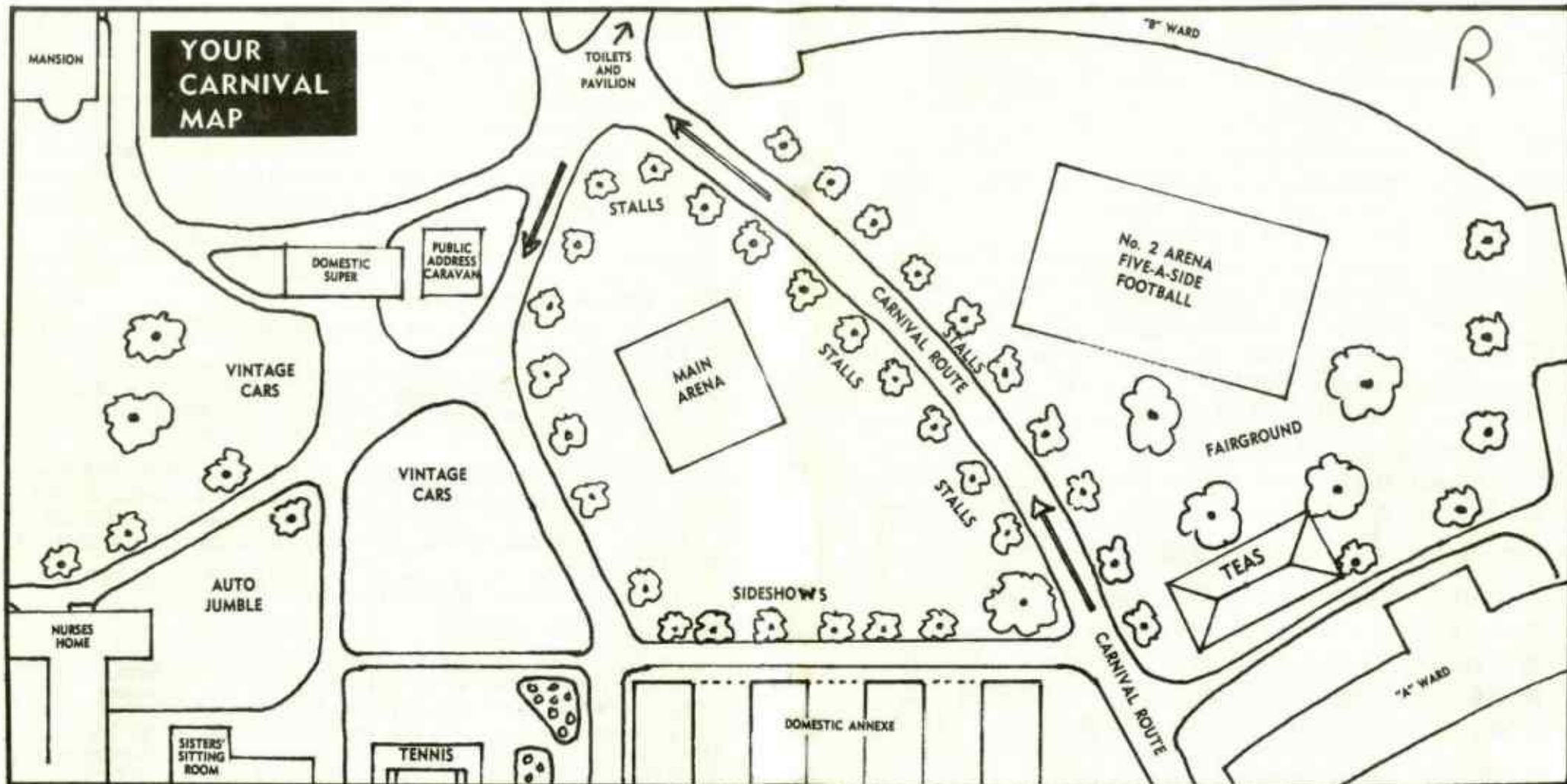
