THE HIGHLAND GATHERING

This year we are bringing the Highland Games to Harefield Hospital, we wish you *CEUD MILE FAILTE* (A hundred thousand welcomes). Miss M. Holbrook who was, until recently, our Director of Nursing Services has consented to be our Chieftainess and will preside over the Games. The Games will be staged by THE HIGHLAND GATHERING ENTERTAINMENT.

Every year many Highland Games and Gatherings take place throughout the summer months all over Scotland. Although they are basically the the same with traditional sports and cultural competitions, may have their own unique event or speciality, this may be a Hill race, a speciality Heavy Sports event, a parade etc. Some have Pipe Band contests, some do not. This applies to Solo Piping, Highland Dancing and even the Heavy Sports, also some Games are very small like a village fete and others very large. The most famous Gathering is Braemar which the Royal Family visits, this is a medium sized event. By far the best event to visit without doubt, is the Cowel Gathering at Dunoon. A 2 day event with many competitors in all events from Novice to the finest exponent in the world. Many come from overseas to take part at this Gathering. It is also known as the Mecca of the Pipe Band world with 160 Pipe Bands taking part in the 6 grades. THE HIGHLAND GATHERING ENTERTAINMENT Highland Games is presented to give you an idea of what a traditional Highland Games is like and you can even have a wee shot at tossing the caber. Complete with Pipe Band and Highland Dancers etc. you will feel you are in the heart of the Highlands and our comentator will tell you all about the events.

THE HIGHLAND GATHERING ENTERTAINMENT was founded in 1980 in the name of The Highland Gathering Pipe Band. From the outset the accent was to be on presenting Traditional Scottish cultural entertainment. It was therefore inevitable the word Entertainment would eventually form part of the title. THE HIGHLAND GATHERING ENTERTAINMENT can provide anything from a solo piper through to a complete days entertainment with cabaret or Scottish Evening, also specialising in ceremonials from weddings to parades and funerals. Already members of the organisation have performed as far away as Venezuela and Finland, played part of the music for Chariots of Fire, filmed with Stephanie Powers and played in most of London's top Hotels, Clubs and night spots.

Our Charities include The Royal British Legion, the Scout Movement, the War Widows Association of Great Britain and others. The Pipe Band has already been successful in competitions, the Highland Dancers are Champions and our heavy sportsman has been British Veteran Heavy Sports Champion.

Enjoy Harefield Hospitals' own Highland Games, and Haste Ye Back to support the hospital next year.
