I can now tell you that her funeral will take place in the afternoon of Friday 19th November. The arrangements are as follows:-

There will be a commemorative service at St Mary's Parish Church UB9 6DU starting at 1.30pm.

This will be followed by a committal service at Breakspear Crematorium HA4 7JS at 2.45pm

A post funeral gathering at Harefield United FC Social Club, UB9 6NE where food and drink will be provided (there will also be a bar available) from 3pm.

Our members are very welcome to attend. If coming we are asked to wear clothing in keeping with Lorraine, which means cheerful and colourful.

It is requested that no flowers be sent. There will simply be a white rose and a red rose placed on the coffin.

As is now customary donations will be welcomed, and these will go to the British Trust for Ornithology. Lorraine gained much pleasure over the years from watching birds in her garden and then recording them and sending the records to the B.T.O. as part of their garden watch, the statistics from which (including mammals, bees and butterflies as well) are a serious and vital source of data for biodiversity in the UK.
